

Birthday Birdy "Peekaboo" Pull Card

Stamp Set & Die:






1. Cut 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" Caribbean Breeze cardstock in half to form card base.
2. Stamp "Happy Bird-Day" in upper left and "To You" in lower right of 4" x 5 1/4" white cardstock, and adhere to card base.
3. Adhere 3" x 3" Caribbean Breeze cardstock to right side of card of card front, as shown in sample photos.
4. To make the "peekaboo" pull piece, cut a standard 8 1/2" x 11" sheet of copy paper (i.e., text weight/printer paper) into two 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces. Set aside one piece to make another project later on.
5. Fold the other 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece in half across the short side, and place it onto the Never-Ending Square die with the fold positioned along the edge of the decorated side of the die. Carefully turn over the paper/die to prevent slips, and place it onto the cutting pad. Add a scrap piece of cardstock as a shim on top, before adding the upper machine plate.
6. Run the paper/die through the machine, and remove all the pieces. (Save the flower centers to embellish your project later on.) Take the largest piece, which will form the "peekaboo" pull piece, pre-fold on the score lines, and open up the piece.



7. Take the top middle fold, and pull it over to the right adjacent fold. Repeat with the bottom middle fold, as shown in photos below.



8. Take the left middle fold, and pull it over to the upper adjacent fold. Repeat with the right middle fold, as shown in photos below.




9. Turn piece over. It should look like this:




10. Place Scor-Tape in the valleys you just created by making the folds in steps #7-8.



11. Remove tape liners, and adhere the folded sections together. The piece should now look like this:




12. When you turn the piece over, it should look like this:




13. Fold each of the taped flaps back and forth, in both directions.




14. Put score tape on each of the flaps, as shown in photo below.



15. Remove tape liners, and press the flaps downward.
16. Turn the piece over, and check to make sure it looks like this:



17. Make mountain folds on the middle squares, as indicated with red lines in photo below.




18. The left photo shows each of the mountain folds make a set of flaps that can be pulled straight upward. The middle and right photos show the flaps being pushed back downward in a counter-clockwise direction.



19. The left photo shows the “peekaboo” pull piece adhered to a green 3” x 3” panel. For your card, attach the piece to the Caribbean Breeze panel on the card base. Make sure to apply adhesive *only* to reverse side of upper left square, and do not allow adhesive to extend past edges of that square.

The middle photo shows the piece once it’s been opened by pulling the lower right square downward and to the right.

The right photo shows a purple 1 1/4” x 1 1/4” square adhered underneath the open die-cut square area, which is for illustrative purposes only.



For your card, stamp the birthday birdy image (head with party hat) onto 1 1/4” x 1 1/4” white cardstock. Color image with pencils and blend with Gamsol. Attach birthday birdy piece to Caribbean Breeze panel in the proper position on the card base, so that birdy peeks through opening as shown in right sample photo on next page.

20. Die-cut flower pieces from Grape Delight, Lime Crush, and Raspberry Splash cardstock. Assemble flowers using liquid glue and adhere to “peekaboo” pull-out piece with glue dots, as shown in sample photos below.
