

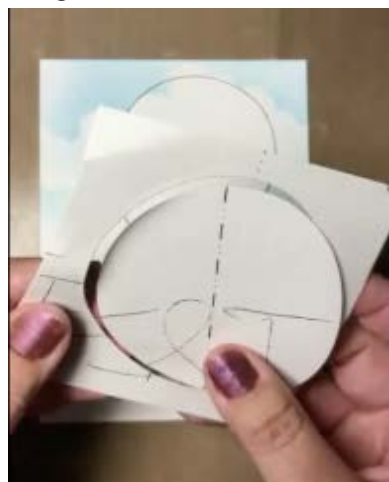
Flippin' Fun Balloon Bunny on Single Panel Cardstock

Stamps, Dies & Fabric:	Cardstock:	Other Supplies:

- Stamp 11459MC Balloon Bunny images on 4 ¼"x 6" panel of white cardstock. Color bunny image and balloon tail as desired. Stamp or stencil background as well, if desired.



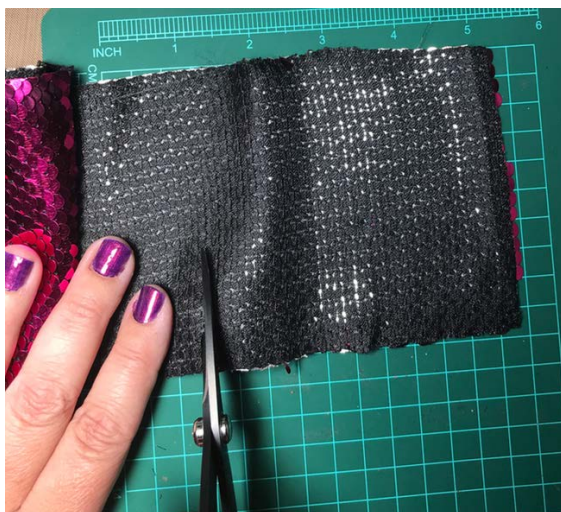
- Create mask for balloon image, by using balloon die to cut a scrap piece of card stock. Use lightweight cardstock, to avoid indentations when using as a mask. The mask will serve as a carrier piece for when cutting out the center of the balloon on your stamped image, to ensure proper alignment.



- Place mask over top of stamped balloon image, and secure with removable tape. Place balloon die inside mask, cutting side down, and run through die cutting machine. Once cutting is complete, remove die, mask and cut piece from single panel.



- Flip panel over to backside. Place Scor-Tape or Red Line Tape around all edges of die cut area, placing tape end to end for secure adhesion.



- Using scissors or rotary cutter, cut a 4" x 4" square of Rainbow Hologram to Silver Hologram Sequin Fabric. Adhere fabric to tape, sequin side down, onto the die-cut area. Make sure that the fabric is flat and that sequins are positioned to flip in desired direction.

6. Make sure that fabric is taut, and apply Scor-Tape or Red Line Tape to all edges of fabric, as well as to the back of fabric so that when “flippin” occurs, material will not sag. Apply Scor-Tape or Red Line Tape to perimeter of panel, where fabric has been adhered, so that panel will adhere nicely to the cardstock base, covering the backside of the fabric.



7. Score navy cardstock base on the long edge, to create the folded card.



8. Center and adhere bunny panel to navy card base, and, treating bunny panel as a matte, allow edges of navy cardstock be visible.



9. Stamp sentiment inside of card if desired.
